## Blindness ◆ Visual Impairment ◆ Reading & Physical Disabilities




We provide a variety of audio books and magazines on cartridges to eligible NM residents who are unable to read standard printed books due to a disability. All materials are sent via USPS as free priority shipping under "Free Matter for the Blind."

## BARD

Patrons can download books, eBraille, and magazines directly from BARD on their computer, smartphone, or tablet.



The BARD Mobile app works with iOS and Android devices, and is compatible with VoiceOver and Talkback. Downloads synchronize with patron accounts to easily track requests.

We provide braille books to patrons through our partnership with the Utah State Library for the Blind and Disabled.

The NM State Library Books by Mail Program provides large print books.
